Plans and Strategies in Personalised, Precision, or Genomic Medicine



- Personalised Precision Medicine, a paradigm shift in the way that healthcare is provided, more effective prevention, diagnose and treatment strategies are provided and contribute with the sustainability of healthcare systems.
- US, Japan, UK, France, Finland and Germany among others, have been implementing strategies and plans for Personalised, Precision, or Genomic Medicine at a national level to speed up its implementation at clinical setting.
- Fundación Instituto Roche (Roche Institute Foundation) is committed
 - to foster Spain at the forefront of innovation in health and contributing
 - to bring to the present the medicine of the future in our country.
- So that, in 2017 we decided to support the development of a document that would serve as a starting point for a Personalised Precision Medicine National Strategy in Spain.





Main Objective

 - the **equity and access** to top-quality personalised precision care.
 - the **sustainability** of our National Health System.
 - position **Spain on the forefront** of Personalised Precision Medicine.


- Phase 1: Analysis of existing strategies, plans and policies on Personalised, Precision, or Genomic Medicine
- Phase 2: Identification and consensus of the key areas to be develop in the National Strategy
- Phase 3: Validation and consensus on key recommendations
- Phase 4: Report edition, validation, endorsement and publication



Communication Plan

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- Six areas are defined to be taken into account in the design of a strategy of Personalized Precision Medicine at a national level that contributes to the advancement of MPP in Spain
- Needs to be tackle identified and 56 recommendations have been formulated to move forward on the development of Personalized Precision Medicine







- A comprehensive **report published** that could be used as a framework to develop a National Strategy on PPM
- The report have been endorsed by ten scientific societies with a relevant role on the implementation of Personalised Precision Medicine





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Spain needs a national strategy on Precision Personalized Medicine

Some specific aspects related to **sensitive information** must be regulated

A specific **budget** should be allocate for a proper strategy implementation

Specific education on PPM in graduate and postgraduate studies, it is needed



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Reference centres and biobanks network should be encouraged

Ensure compatibility between information systems and Interoperable Electronic Health Record.

Infrastructure and resources for computing handling, analysis and data storage is needed.

A national **coordination framework** of the Strategy should be defined

Enhance awareness on PPM among patients, patient groups and the society in general is a must
