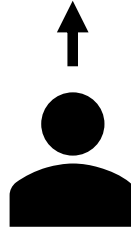
Why National Hubs?

- The field of PM research and implementation is interdisciplinary – a coordinated interaction of different policy and decision makers is necessary
- Responsibilities for PM approaches reside not only with national but also with regional authorities

Aim of National Hubs:

- Pool all resources and expertise in one country and identify the national/regional needs and opportunities.
- National hubs would allow the countries to speak with one voice and would increase their impact in the preparation and maximise the outcome of the EP PerMed.

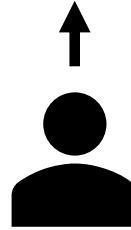

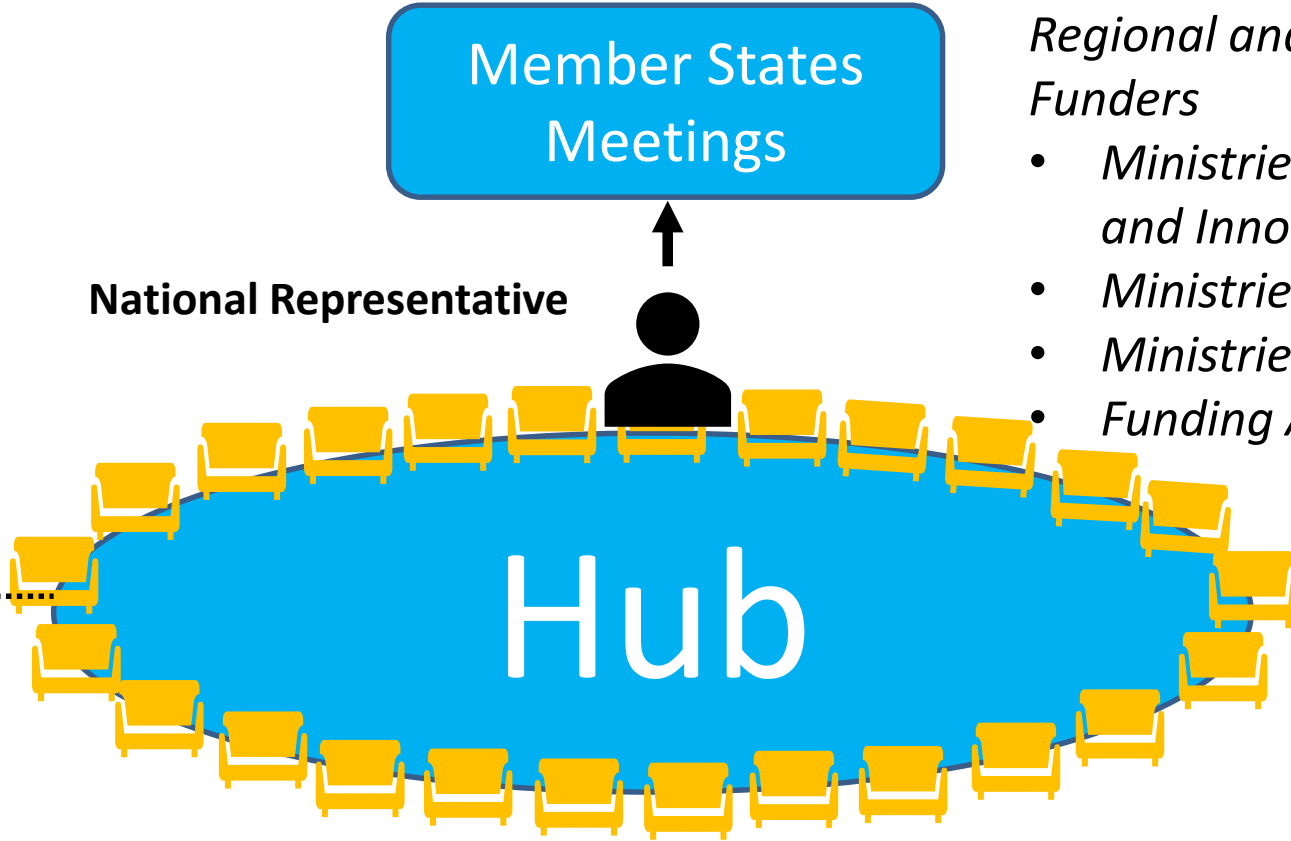

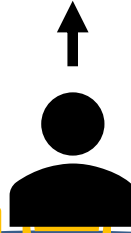

Advantages of National Hub I

- Hubs would build a think tank fostering the implementation of PM and strengthen the PM community within one country
- Exploring synergies allowing a holistic approach of partnership preparation and successful realisation
- Alignment of aims, strategies and activities within one country combined with an increase of transparency and sustainability
- Alignment of dissemination and exploitation activities

Advantages of National Hub II

- Possibility to provide input and contribute actively to the EP PerMed preparations and activities
- Hubs could exchange/collaborate with hubs from other countries and share experiences and information
- **Pooling of national/regional resources maximises impact of investments in national/regional research programmes and healthcare systems**

Consider Country Realities

- The constitution and governance of the national PM hubs would be in the responsibilities of each country.
 - It is recommended that the hub reflects the different aspects/structure of the EP PerMed and allows the country to provide feedback on operational EP PerMed aspects.
- Depending on the organisation of the country, it might be recommended to develop additional regional hubs.
 - In this case they should be represented by at least one person in the national hubs.

- To disseminate the information about the EP PerMed in your countries
- To approach relevant PM stakeholders/networks/contacts in your countries
- To discuss about the future of PM in your countries in order to focus your national interests
- To establish a National Hub because of forementioned reasons
- To support the success of the EP PerMed
